



Road Stud (Cats Eyes) Operative

To safely perform a variety of tasks associated with the installation, removal and maintenance of road studs.

Responsibilities and Duties

- Ensure that all operations carried out within our area of responsibility are undertaken with full regard for the safety of visitors, other members of staff and yourself.
- Ensure all activities are undertaken with due regard for the environment, to prevent pollution, comply with legal and corporate requirements and minimise environmental impact.
- Drive, operate and maintain equipment for application on Highways, and road ways.
- Check performance of the numerous components of various equipment including air compressor, auxiliary engines, pumps, heaters, hydraulic systems, hot melt (stud grout)/air/water and hydraulic lines; trouble shoot equipment failures and report unresolved problems to assigned staff.
- Read interpret and follow construction drawings and specifications as required.
- Perform arithmetic calculations.
- Drive, Operate and maintain hot (200+degrees) hot melt (stud grout) equipment for the application of various studs.
- Carry out other appropriate duties as assigned by the line manager.
- Operate and assist in the operation of vehicles (Banksman).
- Perform manual labour, including the use of hand tools and operate various equipment; drive utility trucks on a daily basis; load and unload equipment supplies and materials.
- Assist in the installation and removal of traffic control operations.
- Perform daily vehicle and equipment inspections as required.
- Maintain daily logs and other records as directed and required.
- Perform other job related duties as directed.
- Ensure adherence to Company policies and Employee safety handbook.
- Requires extensive work schedules on weekdays, and availability to deploy at nights and other times that may be required.
- Regular job functions are carried out in difficult and frequently hazardous working Environments, including extremes of temperature, extensive direct sunlight, night work and heavy traffic situations.
- Regular job functions are carried out in an Environment with exposure to noise, including those associated with, Highways, Construction sites and Construction equipment.
- Frequent exposure to Hot Melt (stud grout) fumes, Chemicals, Chemical fumes and other Environmental substances.

Personal Attributes/Skills

- Essential job functions require maintaining physical condition necessary for light to heavy
- Lifting and carrying, as well as performing work activities that require fine manual dexterity or coordination in operating machines and equipment with steering wheels, buttons, and rocker switches.
- Regular job functions include continuous strenuous activities such as repetitive reaching, bending, lifting, twisting, kneeling, squatting and pulling; prolonged periods of standing and walking; and operating motorized equipment and vehicles.
- Requires explaining facts, interpreting situations, understanding oral and written instructions, and communicating with employees and members of the public.
- Involves the ability to quickly assess and prioritise customer needs.
- Entails the ability to maintain a high level of professionalism with customers and co-workers in high stress situations.
- Obliges the ability to respond in a courteous and helpful manner to customers, members of the public and co-workers who are angry or upset.
- The ability to handle multiple tasks to fulfil job requirements.
- Maintain physical condition appropriate to the performance of the assigned duties.
